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International Study Abroad Scholarship

Criteria:

1. Earn at least 12 credit hours at Delta College **prior** to the trip start date.
2. Earn a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA for courses completed at Delta College **prior** to the trip start date.
3. Recommend that applicants apply for Financial Aid
(Financial aid eligibility determined through Delta's Financial Aid Office (D-101) Scholarship funds will apply towards tuition then travel expenses.)
4. Request Transcript (Student copy is sufficient)

Betty B. and S. Preston Jones International Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship is awarded annually to a *Betty and Preston Jones International Scholar*.

Criteria:

1. Delta College student who is enrolled in an academic program leading to an Associate degree.
2. Successfully completed at least one year of study at Delta College.
3. Achieved a GPA of 2.8 or higher.
4. Written educational plan for academic study, field practicum, or service in another country.

Submit the next four items together in a packet:

- Scholarship Application** — Completed application.
- References** — Include two (2) letters of reference from your past or present Delta Instructors. For **International Study Abroad** programs do not choose instructors who are acting as Trip leaders for the trip that you are applying for. However, applicants for the **Jones Scholarship** should include one letter from the Delta faculty adviser for their educational plan.
- Scholarship Essay** — Include a typewritten essay, 250-word minimum, describing why you want to study in the country you have chosen. Include your educational plans and career goals. You may use the information from **Developing a Study Abroad Goal Statement**, in your essay. Also include commentary on your preparation for study abroad (i.e. cultural knowledge, language, people, exchange, etc.)
- Transcript** (Student copy is sufficient)

Educational Plan — (In addition to the above items, applicants for the Jones Scholarship will submit your written educational plan for learning in another country (i.e. academic study, field work or service); and how this plan will contribute to your career goals. Your plan will require prior approval from a Delta faculty mentor.

Semi-finalists will be invited for an interview. NOT ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE INTERVIEWED.

Submit completed application, including references and essay to Daniel Segura, D101, Delta College, University Center, MI 48710, by **November 15 of the year before you plan to travel**.
