Delta College Biology / General Emphasis, B. S.

NMU's Biology Department offers three separate majors: Biology, Zoology, and Biology/Secondary Education. Students completing a Biology major have the opportunity for further specialization which best prepares them for their desired professional career by choosing from one of four concentrations (emphasis): General Biology, Ecology, Microbiology, and Physiology.

This transfer guide displays required courses for NMU's B.S. degree in Biology/General Emphasis. This emphasis provides an opportunity for a diversified background in biology, applicable to a wide range of introductory positions of employment in business and industry, hospitals, universities, the military, and government. It also provides excellent preparation for graduate work in biology or related sciences.

Note: Students planning to pursue a different Biology emphasis (Ecology, Microbiology, or Physiology), Zoology, or Biology/Secondary Education should refer to the appropriate transfer guide when selecting courses.

Other Graduation Requirements:

1. Students can fulfill NMU's **world cultures** requirement by completing one of the following while at Delta College: GEO 113, GEO 222, GEO 255, GEO 260, GEO 267, GEO 268, POL 222, SOC 231, or SOC 231H;
2. At least one course in the Liberal Studies Program must be at the **300-level or above**. This requirement can be completed before attending the university if the transfer student selects a course that transfers at that level. At Delta College, the following courses meet this requirement: ART 151/152, GEO 222, GEO 223, GEO 260, GEO 261, GEO 262, GEO 267, GEO 268, LIT 245, LIT 246, LIT 268, LIT 271, LIT 271H, LIT 272, LIT 272A, LIT 274, LIT 277, LIT 278, PHL 240, PHL 240H, POL 215, POL 222, or SPH 216.
