Admission to SVSU's Masters of Science in Occupational Therapy program is determined during the Winter semester. Qualified prospective students must submit an application for admission by January 15 preceding the Spring semester for which enrollment is desired.

1. Completion of all required prerequisite and SVSU general education courses available on Delta's website at <http://www.delta.edu/files/Advising-Counseling/GeneralTransferGuides/SVSUBasic.pdf> .
2. Minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA.
3. Interview with SVSU Occupational Therapy Program Director or designee.
4. Additional admission criteria may be required based on interview and record review.
5. Must complete 60 hours of verified work and/or volunteer experience with special needs populations.

The following Pre-OT courses may be completed at Delta prior to admission and transfer to SVSU. It is highly recommended you apply for the MACRAO stamp and complete six "w" credits within SVSU's current General Education categories 2-8.
