- Students may transfer one-half of the credits (62-64 depending on selected concentration) required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be taken at OU. Note: This plan contains more than the allotted 62-64 transfer credits. Consult with a School of Health Sciences advisor for help in limiting credit selection.
- The Physical Therapy Program is an entry level doctorate program. The professional program is three and one-half years in duration. Eligibility to apply requires that the bachelor's degree and pre-requisite courses are completed by the end of summer semester for Fall semester start up. A minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average is required, as is a 2.0 in all pre-requisite courses. (The transfer gpa will be combined with the OU gpa). A bachelor's degree from any accredited college or university qualifies the applicant for consideration. Students need to incorporate the pre-requisite requirements into their degree program. Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.50 in order to be admitted to the Health Science Curriculum.
