

# Public Notice

Delta College is requesting proposals from suppliers for the purchase of equipment, supplies and materials to support the College's Wind Turbine Technology program. The equipment will be installed in the College's Technical Trades and Manufacturing Complex located on the main campus. The Michigan Community College Association (MCCA) has received a U.S. Department of Education Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education (FIPSE) Congressionally-Directed grant. This one-year grant (August 1, 2009-July 31, 2010) supports the implementation of alternative energy projects at 11 Michigan community colleges. Delta College has received a subcontract for \$132,300 to purchase equipment, supplies, and materials to support the College's Wind Turbine Technology associate degree program that was initiated fall 2009. Proposed equipment purchases include AC and DC electronic Drives Trainer(s), Mechanical Drives and Electrical Reley Control.

As a result of this project, students will receive hands-on training and be trained to enter the workforce as a wind turbine technician. To support the growth of green collar jobs, project results will be disseminated through the MCCA to support the implementation of alternative energy programs and curricula at Michigan community colleges.
