Locating Information in Books

- Use [ValCat](#) online catalog to locate books found in the Delta College Library or area Public Libraries.
- Browse the Bookshelves in the Delta Library - books in the LC call number beginning with **N**.
- Use Janson's **History of Art** and Stokstad's **Art History**, available at the Delta Library Reserve Desk under your teacher's name.
- Use **FirstSearch WorldCat**, available from the [Delta Library website \(BOOKS\)](#), either on campus or remotely by using your Delta username and password. You can call Delta Reference Desk at (989 686-9560) to locate books that you can interlibrary loan from worldwide library collections.
- Use **Michigan eLibrary** available from the Delta Library website, to locate books that you can interlibrary loan from other Michigan libraries.
- Use **Michigan Library websites (Catalogs)**, available from the [Delta Library website \(Suggested Library Websites\)](#), either on campus or remotely to locate books that you can interlibrary loan from SVSU, U of M, Library of Michigan and others.

Locating Information in Periodicals

- Use **Art Index** and **Architectural Index**, available in paper on the Index Table in the Delta Library
- Use **EBSCO** online databases: **Humanities Full Text**, **Art Full Text**, and **OmniFile Full Text**, available from the [Delta Library website \(Journal and Magazines\)](#), either on campus or remotely by using your Delta username and password. Call the Delta Reference Desk at 686-9560 to locate articles in magazines, journals, and newspapers - some articles are electronic full-text.
- Interlibrary loan articles that are not in print in the Delta College Library - ask library staff how.
- Browse the **Periodical Shelves** in the Delta Library to locate art magazines and journals.

Locating Information on the WWW

- Use the search engine <http://www.google.com> to find educational or organizational sites. Use the feature "site:edu" or "site:org" . Examples of a google search:

 - jackson pollock and site:org
