



Credit Certificates for Library Activities

Delta librarians have developed a service for teachers to help their students become familiar with library resources. Instead of bringing students into the library for formal instruction, teachers assign a particular library activity and have their students complete that activity in the Delta library. What the student should do to earn a "Credit Certificate" is up to their teacher.

The reference staff will sign a "Credit Certificate" for each individual student with an assigned activity. Students pick up a "Credit Certificate" at the Reference Desk, and then complete the assigned activity. Students will then return the signed "Credit Certificate" to their teacher.

We invite you to use this service. We think it is a good way for teachers to give credit or extra-credit for activities that encourage their students to practice using library resources.
