Use of Force – Skills Training

Everyday, law enforcement officers make decisions in the course of their duties. When use of force is necessary, officers must know when and why they may implement certain levels of force and employ physical controls, weapons and tactics. This eight hour course will look at the use of force continuum, applicable laws and legal decisions. A review of taser training is also included. Some class time will be spent on the range where force on force and live fire exercises will be instructed. Upon completion of this course of training, students will understand the fundamentals of MCOLES use of force continuum and key legislative rulings defining law enforcement use of force. Students will have experienced the dynamics of confrontation in force on force and live fire exercises. **Upon completion of this training, students will have met the MCOLES Active Duty Standard.**

(chemical spray, baton, Taser with one 15' yellow training cartridge); handcuffs; flashlight; and shotgun with 10 rounds of buckshot and 10 rounds of slugs unless your agency only authorizes one type of ammunition which would require 20 rounds of that one type.
