

BUS SERVICE

Delta College is serviced by both Bay Metro Transit (Bay City) and Saginaw Transit Authority Regional Services (STARS). Riders using STARS from Saginaw are required to transfer to Bay Metro at Saginaw Valley State University. You can help to promote a healthy lifestyle for yourself and ensure a cleaner environment for future generations.

The greatest percentage of the Delta College carbon footprint is the emissions generated by commuting to and from campus. Every day, millions of vehicles pump pollutants into our atmosphere. Some of these pollutants fall to earth fouling streams and contaminating crops. Others rise into the stratosphere, damaging the ozone layer and contributing to global climate change. Many cling near the Earth's surface, inhaled with every breath we take.

Using mass transit reduces the impact of automobiles on our roadways and our environment. Travelling in groups decreases the number of vehicles on our roads and reduces the use of gas.

In the Spring of 2010, both services will use mini-Hybrid Thermal conversion kits to transition a total of 16 full-sized buses into eco-friendly fuel-saving modes of transportation. The conversion will increase fuel economy by 3 to 10 percent, reduce emissions and maintenance costs, eliminate the use of hydraulic fluids, and improve safety.
