

### 2010-11 Tech Prep Activities Approved As of 12/31/10

Reimbursement can be made for Tech Prep allowable activities conducted between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011. The purpose of site reimbursements is to provide each participating site with the flexibility to support the development and implementation of Tech Prep 2+2 programs. A Tech Prep student has an EDP that indicates that he/she is enrolled in a State-Board approved, articulated 2+2 career education program either with a Career/Skill Center to a community college, or directly from a high school to a community college or four-year university.

The following activities have been approved for Site Grant reimbursement/Tech Prep funding in 2010-11. Each site is required to have an approved budget submitted/approved through MEGS. Activities must be approved by the State prior to the activity. We are unable to reimburse any activities that do not receive prior approval.

*Note:* Conference reimbursement includes:

- Registration fee
- Lodging-room rate and applicable taxes
- Meals-not included in conference registration at allowable per diem (\$7/11/18) or district policy (whichever is less)
- Transportation-airfare (most cost effective), mileage (at IRS rate or district policy whichever is less), and parking (receipt required)
- Subpay-actual costs for wages/benefits per district policy
