- I give my permission to Delta College to certify my enrollment to the VA for each semester I am registered if payment has been made or sponsorship has been approved. I am required in writing to notify Veteran Services Office if I do not wish to be certified.
- The Veteran's Administration requires that all recipients of veteran educational benefits maintain progress towards their stated academic degree. Therefore, you must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 to remain eligible for VA benefits. If you allow your cumulative GPA to fall below 2.0 you will be placed on probation. You will be allowed two semesters to bring your cumulative GPA up to 2.0. If you fail to do so, the VA will be notified of unsatisfactory progress. Enrollment will not be certified to the VA. Certifications may resume once the cumulative GPA has reached 2.0.
- If you are transferring from another college, you must have your official transcripts sent to Delta as soon as possible for evaluation. If you fail to do so you are subject to having your benefits terminated according to Section 1775 of title 38 U.S. Code.
- You may only receive VA benefits for those courses required for your declared degree program. You will not be certified for courses in which you have previously earned a satisfactory grade for your program.
- You will not be certified for LW / LWT credits unless your program requires a different LW/LWA course. Dependents are exempt. You will not be automatically dropped from LW/LWT classes if you receive credit for military training.
- Classes for which you receive audit (X) or pass/no credit (P/NC) grades are not eligible for benefits.
- You must immediately notify the Delta College Veteran's Office if you make any changes to your class schedule. You are required to notify the Delta College Veteran's Services Office within 10 days of receiving W, WI, and F grades. Delta College is required to report your last date of attendance.
