CIBE Assessment Subcommittee ACTION PLAN for 2023

Purpose: We are a space where assessment efforts at the college come together to reduce assessment silos and identify college-wide patterns. We galvanize (excite, inspire, set into motion) and coalesce (collect, unify, unite) assessment efforts so we can move toward equity, completion and belonging in an innovative way with input from across the college.

We ask high-level questions of assessment at the college: What patterns do we see among unit reviews, program reviews, program assessment, general education assessment, SES assessment? Are their patterns that we need to address institutionally?

How will we do this:

For 2023, we will focus on collecting information on assessment efforts currently underway in various stages across the college. We will invite various individuals who have spearheaded these efforts to our meetings to present on the questions asked in our catalogue template (see below). These individuals will be free to share with us at *whatever stage* they are in the assessment process. In other words, we are NOT a place where people come AFTER they have implemented a perfect assessment plan, but a place to come and share and get feedback and hear ideas from across the college speaking into their efforts, at whatever stage they might be.

CIBE Assessment Committee Chair Lisa Lawrason will send out e-mail invitations to individuals to present at our monthly meetings.

- After each presentation, we will complete the catalogue template as a record of the efforts taking place.

Long-term GOALS:

- Create a catalogue of current assessment work at the college and house it in a place on Inside Delta that is accessible to stakeholders.
- Assess the process of assessment and recommend changes.

Committee Structure & Decision-Making

- Committee shall be comprised of members representing faculty, staff and administration
 - Members will attend meetings, provide input in the direction of the work and take a turn in completing the catalogue template for one of the assessment efforts on campus
- Committee Chair will be responsible for scheduling meetings, running meetings, and developing meeting agendas that moving the committee forward in achieving its goals. The chair will invite key personnel from across the college to present on their assessment efforts.
 - o Term: One year
- Committee Note-Taker will be responsible for taking notes at meetings and posting them to Microsoft Teams
 - o Term: One year
- Decisions will be made by a majority vote after committee members have an opportunity to provide input
- Presenters will have the opportunity to complete the catalogue assessment template; however, if they prefer that we do it, committees members will rotate the responsibility of completing it. The committee member who completes it will give the presenter the opportunity to review it and give feedback before submitting it to the Assessment Catalogue.
