Partnerships

Who, What, Where, When, Why and How?

- ▶ **Who** - Over 40 Transfer University Partners
- ▶ **What** - Transfer Articulation Agreements vs. Transfer Guides, Reverse Transfer, MiTransfer
- ▶ **Where** - Primarily in Michigan, Delta's Top 10, special - JSU and WGU
- ▶ **When** - 2 months to 20+ Years
- ▶ **Why** - Associate to Bachelor's pathway
- ▶ **How** - University Colleagues, Faculty, Advising, Students, Career Demand



Types of Transfer Partnerships

 - 3+1 Agreement (90 +30)
 - 2+2 Agreement (62+60)
- Other Transfer Agreements
 - Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA)
 - Multi-Institutional Statewide Agreements
 - MiTransfer Pathways
 - MiWorkforce Pathways
 - Reverse Transfer Agreements (14)

Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA)

- ▶ Successfully complete at least 30 credits of MTA approved courses, with a minimum of a "C" (2.0) or better in each course.
- ▶ One course in College Composition
- ▶ One course in College Composition or Communication
- ▶ Two courses in Humanities from different disciplines (COM)
- ▶ Two courses in Social Sciences from different disciplines (HIS or PSY for AA/AS)
- ▶ Two courses in Natural Science from different disciplines (at least one with a lab)
- ▶ One course in Mathematics (MTH 122W, 151, 160 and above)

 - ▶ AFA, AAA CJ to Gen Applied Sc
- ▶ Healthcare
 - ▶ 8 AAS to FSU Allied Health
- ▶ Information Technology
 - ▶ (AAS CSIT Program. or Network to DU App Bus or FSU BS Computer Info Tech - electives

Reverse Transfer

- ▶ Student transfers without completing a Delta degree
- ▶ Completed at least 24 credits at Delta before transfer
- ▶ Complete at least 38 credits at University
- ▶ University will send transcript back to Delta (free)
- ▶ Evaluated for major, AA, AS, AGS
- ▶ Degree awarded if requirements are complete
